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TASK-BASED LANGUAGE LEARNING FOR TOURISM



The "Task-Based Language Learning for Tourism: Innovative foreign language teaching method in VET as support to tourism sector" project aims to address the issue concerning language and soft skills proficiencies of those active in tourism sector by upskilling VET and English language educators in the use of TBLT, an innovative language learning methodology.

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Training activity in Barcelona

The Training activity was delivered by SLB in November 2023 in Barcelona, Spain, in cooperation with York Associates (YA). The activity involved a 3-day training session focusing on the practical implementation of TBLT.

SLB also invited guest speakers, Geoff Jordan expert in the field of TBLT, who is also a well-known ELT personality. YA contributed by sharing their pedagogical expertise, innovative approaches, and supporting the development of TBL-based learning units. Their role also included monitoring the quality of the training outcomes due to their proficiency in language education.

Final partners meeting in Čačak

The 5th and final Transnational Project Meeting for the TBL 4 Tourism project was held on the 19th and 20th of February 2024 in Čačak, Serbia. The meeting focused on the finalization of the few remaining tasks, particularly related to PR2 and PR3, and the consolidation of project outcomes into deliverable formats.
